2. Presentation on Service Line Warranty Program. Dennis Lyons from the National League of Service Lines Warranty Program presented to the Mayor, City Council and others present. This program is endorsed by the National League of Cities and Towns and the Utah League of Cities and Towns. Municipalities receive calls from homeowners when a problem arises with their exterior water or sewer service lines. They often learn, for the first time, that the municipality is not responsible for the portion of the line on private property. The NLC Service Line Warranty Program provides for repair or replacement of residents' line by local, licensed and insured contractors, who preform repairs per city code. There is no cost to the municipality to participate. There is voluntary participation for the residents. There is 24/7 customer service, 365 days a year.

MOTION: Bo Harrison made a motion to approve the Mayoral Appointments as stated. Larry Packer seconded the motion. **VOTE:** Michael Silliman, Kent Nelson, Bo Harrison, Kathy Ryan and Larry Packer voted aye. The motion carried.

4. Discuss schedule for hiring new Museum Executive Director. The City is unfortunately losing Director Tim Glenn. The hiring committee is formed which consists of Mayor Bacon, Tim Glenn, Larry Packer, Cameron Wilford and Roy Webb. The job announcement has been out for a week. Conae Black said we need to have one member of the committee take the lead. Bo Harrison asked where the job has been advertised. Conae Black said Department of Workforce Services, Indeed, Museum Associations and the City web site. He asked if there were any locals that had applied. Conae Black said so far one of the applicants is local. Larry Packer said he would take the lead on the hiring committee.

Michael Silliman joined the meeting at 7:48 p.m.

5. Department and employee reports. Robin Nelson introduced that Pot Luck will be starting up again. There is an organized OHV ride scheduled in Green River this weekend. She reported on the upcoming events such as Rock and Mineral Show, River Festival and Outlaw Days. She and Kent Nelson are working on getting the Trails Committee re-established. Bryan Meadows said the crew has been repairing water leaks. He has been getting information to Brown and Caldwell and Sunrise Engineering for outstanding projects. Repairs need to be made on the Loader and Backhoe. Since it is Burn Season they have been burning weeds along the ditches. Sewer lagoons are full so he has been discharging into the river. Michael Silliman reported on the parks. Bo Harrison attended his first Planning Commission meeting. Kathy Ryan said that she will be attending the Flaming George meeting. GRIT is planning a cleanup picnic for June 4th. She had been attending the Water Shed meetings. Mayor Bacon read Phillip Stubblefield's report. He is serving on the GRIT Committee. The Pride in Property signs will be going out soon. He is getting some door hangers and wants to find a way to dispose of used tires. Mayor Bacon reported on the Council of Governments meeting and prioritizing the county wide CIB list. He met with the White Sands Missile Base Colonel about the status of the Green River missile base. Natural Gas Bill has been approved and signed by the Governor. Conae Black has been working on amendments to the sign ordinance and grants for the river enhancement project.
