1. Introduction of the new Travel Council Director. Adriana Chimaras introduced herself to the City Council and what the Travel Council has been working on and continue to work on.

2. Council and Employee reports. Anna Evans met with the Planning Commission who approached her to look into swapping BLM with SITLA. She made some contacts and found out some information on how that can or cannot be done. Kathy Ryan is meeting with J&T Engineering about the State Safe Sidewalks to School program and determines an area where they would like to see sidewalks. Kim Andrus she is working on forming a citizens committee to help with animal control. There is a shooting event coming up for the Boy Scouts. The job has been posted for a new Code Enforcement Officer. Penney Riches has put in a request with the Emery County weed and mosquito department to spray for mosquitos. The museum is holding the Powell After Hours event this Saturday. The museum is putting in a new security system. The museum was awarded a \$20,000 grant that can be used for any need they have. Michael Silliman got table tops for the tree stumps at the park and would like to remove the broken cement tables on the north side of the park. Someone has been setting a fire at the city landfill which is not approved by the State. The consensus is to put cameras up to catch whoever is doing that. There has been some vandalism at the park restrooms. Bryan Meadows is working hard on getting the water quality in compliance with all regulations. The two new employees are working hard. They are pleased with the sewer vacuum truck and dump truck that was just acquired. Robin Nelson is working on trails, July 4<sup>th</sup> event, a river festival and cowboy day's festival. Conae Black said there has been a lot of building permits this month from a re-roofing to the new Holiday Inn Express.

3. Discuss/approve/deny Grant Offer for Airport Improvement Program Project No. 3-49-0010-012-2019 at the Green River Airport for a Master Plan. Conae Black said this is the final step that the FAA requires. **MOTION:** Kim Andrus approved having Mayor Bacon sign off on all grant documents for the Airport Improvement Program Project No. 3-49-0010-012-2019 which is for the Master Plan. Anna Evans seconded the motion. **VOTE:** Michael Silliman, Penney Riches, Kim Andrus, Kathy Ryan and Anna Evans voted aye. The motion carried.
